GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS WHO ENTER IN 10TH GRADE

Subject	Requirement
Art	3 credits (or full-year credit course at previous school in visual or performing arts)
Co-Curriculum	3 one-mod internships (one in 10 th , 11 th , and 12 th)
English	9 credits (three per year)
History	6 credits (must include 10 th and 11 th grade history courses, or equivalent per Academic Office) + 1 credit of research
Mathematics	9 credits
Science	6 credits (must show completion of Biology, Physics, and Chemistry)
World Languages*	6 credits
Interdisciplinary	2 credits (including one of coding or credit from previous school and one student life credit)
Activities	3 seasons yearly, at least two of which must be team experiences

** International Student English is 6 credits and replaces the World Language requirement. Placement in the International Student English program is part of the admission decision.*
